Steps to become a Christian:

- 1) Admit you are a sinner. Admit that it is impossible for you to be good enough for God if you try to do it by yourself.
- 2) Believe that Jesus Christ hung on the cross and suffered the penalty of your sins so that you may have forgiveness, and that only through Christ can you be good enough for God.
- 3) Repent, or promise to repent, from your sin. Sometimes it can take a while to remove sin from your life, but promise to try and do your best to keep your promise.
- 4) Receive Christ into your heart through prayer.

Now that you are a Christian:

- 1) Continue to Pray. Pray every day if possible. You don't always have to get down on your knees, you can pray anywhere at any time. You can speak to God out loud, or you can just think your prayer to yourself. God will hear you either way.
- 2) Read the Bible. The Bible contains the word of God, which tells us how we are to live or lives. As you read the Bible, if you come across a verse that really speaks a great deal to you, then memorize it. Try to read at least a little bit every day. Make a habit of it so it becomes easy to do.
- 3) Fellowship with other Christians. Go to the church of your choice or get together with other Christian friends and talk about God, Jesus, and the Bible. There is strength and support in numbers.
- 4) Witness to others what God has done in your life. Don't be afraid.
- 5) Recognize that the devil will try to destroy what God has built. Now that you are a child of God and belong to the Lord, the devil is your enemy. The devil will try to steal you away from the Lord through temptation, but you need to do your best to stay on the righteous path. Whenever you encounter a problem or a temptation that you think is too big for you to handle, pray to God for Him to help you.
- 6) The Lord may give you trials to build you spiritually. Through suffering, we learn about ourselves and we become stronger people, stronger Christians, and stronger witnesses for God.
